Children with Statements of Special Educational Needs or Education, Health Care Plans (EHCP) are catered for according to the requirements. The school's SEN-D Policy, provides equal opportunities and additional opportunities for SEN-D pupils to learn and make progress according to need.

The school also supports 'looked after' children - working closely with carers and social workers to ensure inclusion at all levels. Teachers, in liaison with the Headteacher, plan the provision and support for all SEN-D pupils.

We also have a number of highly trained support workers who deliver programmes of work, specialising in speech and language therapy, autism, dyslexia and behaviour to meet the needs of all our pupils.
